**What did Lillian Smith do?** Renowned for her controversial books exploring segregation, white supremacy, and other social mores, author Lillian Smith was an advocate of racial reform in the South.

In addition to his scientific research work, Tyson has written many popular books about science, including Astrophysics for People in a Hurry and The Pluto Files: The Rise and Fall of America's Favorite Planet.

**Has Neil deGrasse Tyson published anything?** New York City, New York, U.S. From 1995 to 2005, Tyson wrote monthly essays in the "Universe" column for Natural History magazine, some of which were later published in his books Death by Black Hole (2007) and Astrophysics for People in a Hurry (2017).

**Is the universe really 14 billion years old?** The universe at approximately 13.8 billion years old is much older than Earth. Earth is 4.5 billion years old.

**How does the scientist prove that the universe is around 14 billion years old?** We do not know the exact age of the universe, but we believe that it is around 13 billion years - give or take a few billion. Astronomers estimate the age of the universe in two ways: (a) by looking for the oldest stars; and (b) by measuring the rate of expansion of the universe and extrapolating back to the Big Bang.

Neil earned his BA in Physics from Harvard and his PhD in Astrophysics from Columbia.

**What existed before the universe?** The initial singularity is a singularity predicted by some models of the Big Bang theory to have existed before the Big Bang. The instant immediately following the initial singularity is part of the Planck epoch, the earliest period of time in the history of our universe.

**How do we know the universe is 14.5 billion years old?** Astronomers have derived two different measurements of the age of the universe: a measurement based on direct observations of an early state of the universe, which indicate an age of  $13.787 \pm 0.020$  billion years as interpreted with the Lambda-CDM concordance model as of 2021; and a measurement based on the observations ...

**What is the oldest thing on the universe?** With a redshift of  $z = 8.2$ , at the time of observation, the burst was the most distant known object of any kind with a spectroscopic redshift. GRB 090423 was also the oldest known object in the Universe, apart from the Methuselah star. The light from the burst took approximately 13 billion years to reach Earth.

**What star is older than the universe?** Methuselah is believed to be the oldest star in the entire known universe, having formed over 14 billion years ago. Its age makes it older than the universe itself. Another mystery added to the list of those involving our universe.

**What is Neil deGrasse Tyson thesis?** 00:01:44. For his second attempt at a PhD this time at Columbia University, Tyson took a stab at understanding why the centre of our galaxy is the way it is. His thesis has the title, A Study of the Abundance Distributions Along the Minor Axis of the Galactic Bulge. It was published in 1992, when he was 33.
