If you have lost your installer code, you can alternatively use the backdoor method to get into programming. This is done by pressing and holding the \* and # keys within 50 seconds of powering on the system.

## **How do I program my Ademco panel?**

**What is the default keypad address for VISTA-20P?** Keypads have to be addressed 16 to 23 (no duplicates), but come defaulted at 31 and will not work until they are re-addressed. Field 20 (Installer Code) will be displayed on the screen.

**What is the power supply voltage for the VISTA-20P alarm system?** The power source for a Honeywell VISTA 20P is the Honeywell 1321 AC Transformer. This is a 16.5VAC, 25VA transformer that will provide reliable power to the system. A backup battery of at least 12V, 4Ah can also be added to keep the system running in the event of an electrical outage.

**What is the default installer code for Ademco alarm?** The default Installer Code for all Honeywell/Ademco alarm panels (hardwired and wireless) is 4112. You can always try the default Installer Code first but it would be unusual for a security dealer to not change the code as part of their installation procedure.

**How do I find master code on VISTA 20P?** The Master Code is set to 1234 by default, but it should be changed for security purposes. The Master Code is not used for deep-level programming or making advanced system changes. The code used for that purpose is the Installer Code, which is 4112 by default.

**What is the default user code for VISTA 20P?** The Master Code is the main system code for arming and disarming. On a VISTA 20P and most other Honeywell Systems, it is set to 1234 by default. However, nearly all users will want to change this default code for security purposes. The Master Code should not be confused with the system's Installer Code.

**What is the password for VISTA 20P?** The default master code of any Vista panel is 1234. To change that master code, you have to type the master code in first, followed by a sequence of numbers.

**How many hardwired zones does a Vista 20P have?** The Vista-20P supports a total of 48 hardwired zones. Zone 1 can interface with 2-wire smokes. Zones 2 - 8 can be used as single zones, or doubled to provide up to 14 hardwired zone inputs. Using up to five Honeywell 4219 zone expanders, a total of 48 hardwired zone inputs can be achieved.

**How many 2 wire smokes does a Vista 20P have?** Basically that's as simple as that for the wiring for a two-wire smoke. That simple for the programming and just remember only 16 smokes to zone one. You can have up to 16 and that's it.

**How do I exit programming mode in VISTA 20P?** Press ?98. Exits programming mode and prevents re-entry by: Installer Code + 8 + 0 + 0.

**How do I add users to my Ademco VISTA 20P?** Adding User Code: Enter your 4-digit Master Code. Press [8] then the User Number (03 for example – User Numbers Range from 03 to 33) Enter in new 4-digit user code once (ex. 1234 8 03 5678)
