Where does the Bible talk about the kingdom of darkness? Such is the case with Col. 1:13-14: “He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.”

What does the Bible say about the darkness of the world? A key verse to determine the power of darkness is John 1:5, “The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.” This is the best news: we need not fear the darkness. Darkness will never eclipse light, nor will the dark devil overcome the Light of the world—Jesus Christ.

What is the difference between the Kingdom of God and the Kingdom of darkness? God's kingdom is filled with light, truth, joy, compassion, comfort, and triumph in sorrow. God ultimately transforms His children into the image of his Son (Romans 8:28-29). Satan's kingdom leads to death, deception, and destruction (John 10:10).

What does Kingdom of darkness mean? And when they fell for Satan's lie and disobeyed God's command, their sinful rebellion handed this world over to Satan. This is when the world became the kingdom of darkness. The point is, if you're not going to follow God's will, you'll end up following Satan's will.

How does God call us out of darkness? According to Peter, God has “called us out of darkness into his marvelous light.” It is this marvelous light that we see in the face of Jesus Christ. Not only does he call us to be lights in a dark and troubled world. He calls himself the “light of the world.” He is a living light that shines over us and ahead of us.

How to overcome the kingdom of darkness? We must turn from our selfish ways and acknowledge that Jesus is our rightful King. We must let Him tell us what to do. By God's mercy on account of the cross, we can receive His forgiveness and escape from the kingdom of darkness, gaining love, joy, and peace in the Kingdom of light forever.
