Army Regulation 670-1 explains that Retired Soldiers not on active duty are not authorized to wear their uniforms except under limited circumstances, such as while performing Reserve Officer Training Corps instructor duties, while attending military funerals, memorial services, weddings, inaugurations, and other occasions ...

Is it okay to wear old military clothing as a civilian? No person shall wear any part of the uniform of the national guard or the army, navy or air force of the United States, or a uniform so similar as to be easily mistaken therefor, unless the person is a member of the service whose uniform he wears, an inmate of a veterans' or soldiers' home, or a member of an ...

Is the black beret still authorized? Since June 14, 2001, a black beret is worn by all U.S. Army troops unless the soldier is approved to wear a different distinctive beret.

When did the US Army stop wearing blue? The Army Blue Service Uniform, which was the sole service uniform between 2015 and 2020, is used primarily as a dress uniform for ceremonial occasions or formal social situations. Over history, a number of different non-combat service uniforms have been authorized by the Army.

What are the three dots on Army uniforms? Cadet captains wear three discs or dots. The insignia changes at major—the first of the field-grade officers.

Do soldiers get to keep their uniforms? (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c), when an enlisted member of an armed force is discharged, the exterior articles of uniform in his possession that were issued to him, other than those that he may wear from the place of discharge to his home under section 772(d) of this title, shall be retained for ...

Do military pay for their own uniforms? Enlisted members get an initial-issue allowance for uniforms, shoes, boots and insignia when they come on active duty. Because uniform requirements are different for each service as well as for men and women, payments vary by service and gender.

Can I wear my military uniform to my wedding? Wearing military uniforms at weddings is subject to personal choice and certain exceptions. Not all uniforms are suitable for all settings. You may choose formal civilian attire if the wedding is informal or non-traditional.

What military gear is illegal to sell? The Defense Property Disposal Service was a program established under the Defense Supply Agency in 1972. This office is in charge of distributing military surplus items to both law enforcement agencies and the public. By law, the public is not permitted to purchase strategic items, ammo and explosives.
