What is the significance of the 3 in Oedipus Rex? Oedipus killed King Laius at a place "where three roads meet," or a triple crossroad. Typically, crossroads symbolize a choice to be made. Yet because the murder of Laius occurred in the distant past. Oedipus's choice has already been made, and so the triple crossroads becomes a symbol not of choice but of fate.

What is the last Theban play? The final Theban play is Antigone. It was written in 441 BCE, so it was actually the first of the Theban plays to be performed even though it is the last one in the story. It follows the actions of Oedipus' daughter, Antigone, after her brothers Polyneices and Eteocles have killed each other.

Which of the three Theban plays was probably written first? Antigone was probably the first of the three Theban plays that Sophocles wrote, although the events dramatized in it happen last.

What is the chronological order of the three Theban plays? Written by Sophocles circa 441 BC, Antigone is an Athenian tragedy. Of the three Theban plays, Antigone is the third in order of the events depicted in the plays, but was the first to be written. The reading order of the Theban plays is: Oedipus Rex, followed by Oedipus at Colonus and ending with Antigone.

What is one of the Theban plays? The Theban plays comprise three plays: Oedipus Rex (also called Oedipus Tyrannus or Oedipus the King), Oedipus at Colonus, and Antigone. All three concern the fate of Thebes during and after the reign of King Oedipus.

Oedipus is one of the most well known mythological figures of the ancient Greeks, and he was immortalized in Sophocles' trilogy of plays *Antigone*, *Oedipus the King*, and *Oedipus at Colonus*. Each play in the trilogy is considered among the greatest plays ever written, and they were admired by the Ancient Greeks as well.

What type of play is *Antigone* by Sophocles? *Antigone* (/æˈnʌtɪˈɡɒni/ ann-TIG-?-nee; Ancient Greek: Ἀντιγόνη) is an Athenian tragedy written by Sophocles in (or before) 441 BC and first performed at the Festival of Dionysus of the same year.

Is *Antigone* Euripides or Sophocles? Sophocles builds his plays around real-world issues in ways similar to Euripides: in his *Antigone* (441 BC), the main character also rebels against sexism and societal expectations by refusing to adhere to King Creon's orders not to bury her deceased brother.
