**What are the 4 levels of inquiry?** Luckily, there are many levels of inquiry that students can progress through as they move toward deeper scientific thinking. We've found a four-level continuum—confirmation, structured, guided, open—to be useful in classifying the levels of inquiry in an activity (Figure 1).

**What is the IBL theory?** IBL: In IBL, the teacher takes on a more facilitative role, guiding students through the inquiry process and encouraging them to explore and construct their own understanding. The teacher's primary responsibility is to provide support, resources, and scaffolding for students navigating the inquiry process.

**What is plug load management?** Plug load control comes in two basic forms. Energy savings are achieved when the device is either transitioned to a low-power state, or it is de-energized to eliminate the power draw. Both can be executed either manually or automatically. A low-power state is between a de-energized state and a ready-to-use state.

### **How to improve plug load efficiency?**

**What is an example of a plug load?** Plug loads refer to energy used by equipment that is plugged into an outlet. In an office, key plug loads include computer and monitors, printers, and copiers.

**What are plug and process loads?** Plug and process loads (PPLs) are building electrical loads that are not related to lighting, heating, ventilation, cooling, and water heating, and typically do not provide comfort to the occupants. PPLs in commercial buildings account for almost 33% of U.S. commercial building electricity use (McKenney et al).

### **How do you calculate plug loads?**

**Where is plug load control required?** Office plug loads are the loads with the largest power density (W/ft<sup>2</sup>) in most office buildings. The Energy Standards require controlled and uncontrolled 120-volt receptacles in lobbies, conference rooms, kitchen areas in office spaces, copy rooms, and hotel/motel guest rooms.

**How many watts per square foot is a plug load?** The typical office building has a plug load of about 1.0 watts per square foot.

**How can I make my device more energy efficient?** Numerous methods exist to reduce a product's energy consumption, particularly when it involves charging. For example, replacing a traditional charging cable with a solar panel and rechargeable batteries can substantially reduce energy usage.

**What will increase the efficiency of an electrical system?** You can do this by using energy-efficient components, reducing the resistance and impedance of the system, balancing the load and the power factor, improving the insulation and grounding of the system, and implementing renewable energy sources and smart technologies.

**What is plug-in equipment?** A plug-in machine is a piece of electrical equipment that is operated by being connected to an electricity supply or to another piece of electrical equipment by means of a plug.

**What are the 5 electrical loads?**

**What is the maximum load of a plug?** The largest rated plug fuse is 13A where the socket outlet circuits are protected by a circuit breaker rated at 32A maximum for a ring circuit or 20A for a radial circuit. If the fuse doesn't blow, the circuit breaker protecting the distribution circuit will open.

**How to reduce plug load?** Motion Activated Switch or Power Strip. The key to reducing plug loads is to turn products off when they are not being used. One strategy is to use an activity monitor power strip (a type of advanced power trip) or a motion controlled wall switch that turns outlets off.

**What is the efficiency of plug load?** In minimally code-compliant office buildings, plug loads may account for 25% or less of total energy consumption; in high efficiency buildings, plug loads may account for more than 50% of the total energy consumption (Poll, S. and C. Teubert 2012).

**What is a plug load management system?** Monitors the energy consumption of electronic appliances that are plugged into electrical sockets. Enables appliances to be turned on or off according to a user defined schedule.

**How do you calculate equipment loads?** Some appliances might state The power rating in amps (A) and volts (V). You can use the load calculation formula,  $\text{Power (W)} = \text{Voltage (V)} \times \text{Current (A)}$ . It will convert the information to watts. Determining Load Types: Electrical loads can differ based on their characteristics.

**How many watts per square foot for warehouse?** ( Note: These are general guidelines and the actual foot-candle requirement may vary depending on the specific needs of each warehouse and the type of work being performed.) Wattage: Choose the right wattage for your needs. A general rule of thumb is to use 50-75 watts per 1000 square feet of floor space.

**How to calculate load capacity?** You have to isolate the power point or circuit that you want to measure. Take the breaker's size and multiply it by the rated voltage. For example, if you have a 20 amp breaker operating at 120 volts, it will have a maximum load of 2400 watts (20 amps x 120 volts).

**How does plugload work?** This current-sensing outlet controls whether power is supplied to the switched outlets or not. The control device (e.g., TV or PC) must be plugged into this outlet. The Energy Saving outlets will automatically switch off when the control device (e.g. TV or PC) powers off or enters a standby state.

**How do you test an outlet load?** Set your multimeter to ohms and put a probe into one of the outlet slots and the other probe on the nearest terminal screw. The meter should indicate continuity. Test the remaining slot and terminal. Then test the ground slot to the grounding terminal.

**Which plug is load?** The line side of an outlet is where you connect the incoming source power. The load side is where the power leaves the device (or electrical box) and travels down the circuit.
